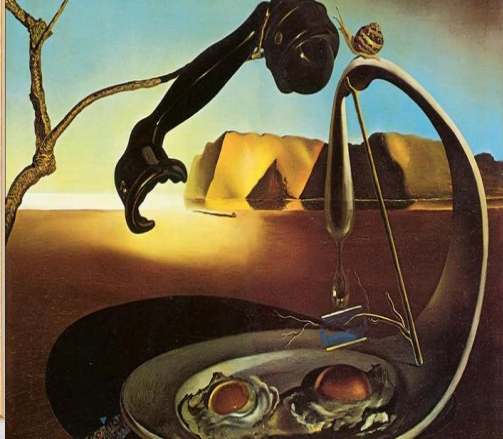

Surrealism:

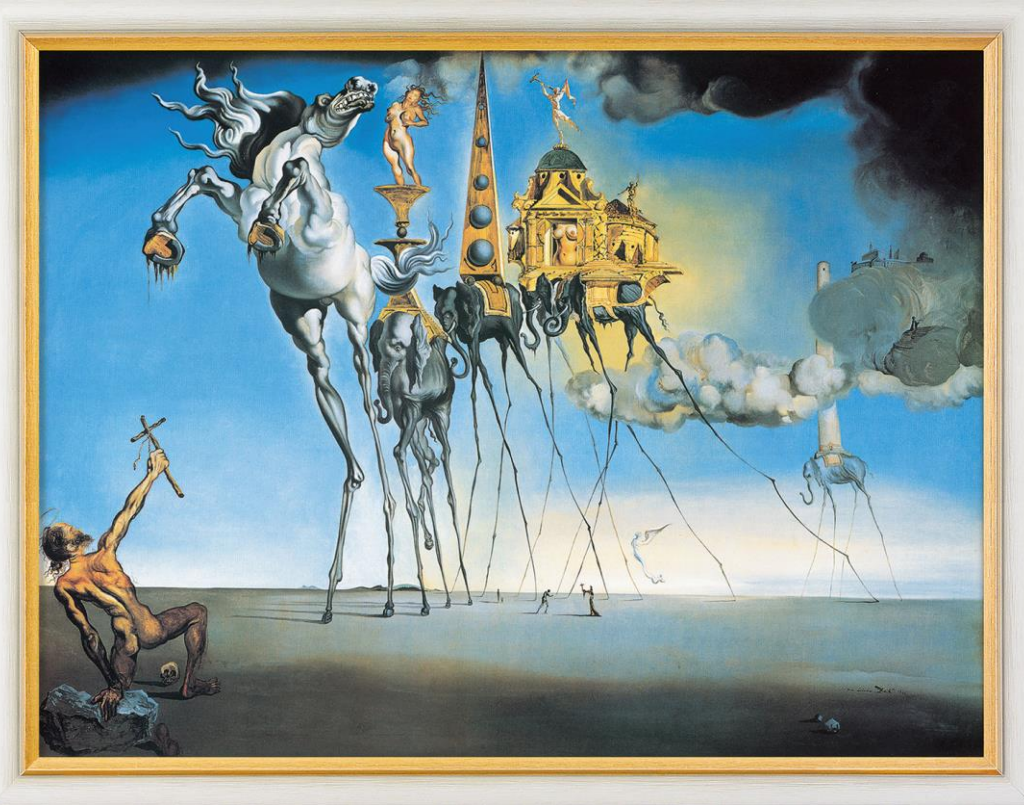
Founded by the poet André Breton in Paris in 1924, Surrealism was a cultural movement which developed in Europe after World War I and was largely influenced by Dada (an art movement aimed to destroy traditional values in art). The movement is best known for its visual artwork, literature and the juxtaposition (contrasting ideas) of unusual imagery. The movement's poets and artists found magic and strange beauty in the unconscious and dreams and this influenced their work greatly.

Task two: Enjoy a virtual tour of the famous Dali Museum in Florida. Explore the largest museum dedicated to the work of Salvador Dali and discover your inner artist!
